What does the first day of school look like?

The first day of school will be Tuesday, September 2nd. Doors will open at 8:15am, and students can enter through the doors on the south side of the building (Junior High Office Area) or the east side of the building (Senior High Office Area). Parents/guardians dropping off their students will pull in on the north side of the building, closest to the railroad tracks, (Student Drop Off & Student Parking Area) or along the east side of the building along 7th Street St. SE in the student drop-off area by the Senior High Office area. Please do not enter our bus drop-off lane or staff parking areas. *Click the attached map for details - click here.*

As the students enter the school, they will be greeted by staff members and guided to the junior high office area where students will receive their new homeroom. On this day, we will ONLY have the grade 7 students in the junior high end. This way they can comfortably get used to the new school and have staff more adequately guide them toward a successful first day.

The entire morning will be dedicated to meeting the homeroom teacher and getting to tour stations around the school. Topics covered during this time include school expectations, meeting additional teachers and wellness coaches, being assigned a locker, receiving a locker agreement, learning about the gym, orienting themselves in the building, familiarizing themselves with our Learning Resource Center (library). The students will also receive their academic timetable. Students are asked to please bring their own lock and combination number.

At 11:29 am, we will open the cafeteria for all students to eat their lunch. Please be aware that our school is considered a closed campus for grade 7 students at lunch time (11:29 am to 12:29 pm).

Students require a permission form to be signed and returned by a parent/guardian to give written consent to leave school premises during the lunch hour. More details and the permission form will be shared with families next week via email. In the afternoon, students will practice cycling through their Day 1 routine to rehearse for the next day.
