What does the first day of school look like?

The first day of school for Grade 10, 11, and 12 students will be Tuesday, September 2nd. Doors will open at 8:15 am, and students can enter through the doors on the south side of the building (Junior High Office Area) or the east side of the building (Senior High Office Area). Parents/guardians dropping off their students will pull in on the north side of the building, closest to the railroad tracks, (Student Drop Off & Student Parking Area) or along the east side of the building along 7th Street St. SE in the student drop-off area by the Senior High Office area. Please do not enter our bus drop-off lane or staff parking areas. *Click the attached map for details - click here.*

As students enter the school, they will be greeted by staff members by the senior high office area waiting to hand out academic timetables to students. Once received, we ask students to proceed directly to their first homeroom classroom. At 8:30 am the bell will go and all senior high students should be present in class. At their homeroom classroom the teachers will explain school expectations, start-up information, receive their locker assignment and locker agreement. Students are asked to please bring their own lock and combination number. At the start of the day, there will be NO changes to timetables at the main office or with career coaches. Students will be given the opportunity to sign up for schedule changes in the main office at break times and lunch. Some students may have a first block spare; they will report to the main office to receive their locker assignment, locker agreement and student academic timetable. If they require any changes to courses, they will be able to sign up for an appointment in the main office.

Throughout the year, lunch will be at 11:29 am until 12:29 pm, and the school day will end at 3:25 pm. Click here for a link to our school bell times.

Students without an assigned homeroom should report to the Senior High Office for assistance.
